Büyük Kolej's accreditation comes from the Council of International Schools (CIS) and is recognized in over 700 schools and 600 universities worldwide. We have benefited greatly as the school in every aspect meets international standards in child protection, students' learning and well-being, and being global citizens.

All CIS member schools are committed to incorporating international and intercultural perspectives into their programmes so that students can move forward with the attitudes and understanding that will provide them with a solid foundation wherever their studies or work may take them.

The purpose of the CIS programme is to provide a professional sound scheme of self-evaluation and independent inspection, particularly for international schools. Involvement in the programme provides a valuable stimulus for schools to think more deeply about their situation and opportunities, and to plan for improvements. Once accredited, the school is locked into a process of regular reviews to ensure continued quality assurance. After undertaking a comprehensive review in 2001, BK was first accredited in Autumn 2005. In April 2015 the school was awarded a second time for a full ten-year re-accreditation by CIS. The next preparatory visit will be in March 2020, and the other five-year re-accreditation process will be in 2021.

FOREIGN LANGUAGES AT BUYUK KOLEJ

Global citizenship and multi-lingual education are highly promoted in Buyuk Kolej. **German, French and Spanish** languages are taught selectively as a second foreign language in our school. In kindergarten, the language learning process begins with 2 class hours a week and it continues as 4 class hours a week during the primary school years. Language learning is a skills-based process and students are aimed to acquire the language in its natural pace and culture. Students are graduated from Primary school, with A1 level language proficiency and to ensure their progress, international exams are in place to certify their proficiency. Besides intensive hours and enriched contents and facilities at school, summer schools to Germany, Spain, and France are organized that promote students' high-quality learning, and understanding of cultural diversity and global perspectives.
